New Castle Presbyterian Church Policies and Procedures

BAPTISM AT NEW CASTLE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Baptism is one of two sacraments celebrated by the Presbyterian Church. The other is the Lord's Supper.

A sacrament is an enactment of God's promises to us and our enactment of response. The experience of a sacrament is of great importance to our understanding of the relationship God offers us.

The central symbol for baptism is water. Ordinary water becomes the seal of God's grace in joining us to Jesus Christ, in washing away sin, and in including us into the family of God that is the church.

By Baptism we join the sacred story of our creation by God, our salvation through the Flood and the Exodus, and our redemption in Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist. Baptism calls us to repentance, faithfulness and discipleship in the world.

Who May Be Baptized

Anyone of any age may be baptized. The Presbyterian Church practices the baptism of children as witness to the truth that God's love claims people even before they are able to respond. Adults witness to God's grace which calls them to respond in a life of faithfulness.

Vows are made for oneself or one's child that:

- profess faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior
- renounce evil and affirm reliance on God's grace
- declare intention to participate actively and responsibly in the worship and mission of the church
- provide for the Christian nurture of one's child.

Baptism is received only once. The Presbyterian Church (USA) recognizes all Baptisms with water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit administered by other Christian churches.

How to Plan for Baptism

First contact the Pastor of the Church. Pre-baptismal counseling with the Pastor is required.

A "Request for Baptism" form will be provided by the Pastor.

Baptism is approved by the Session – the governing group of the church – upon recommendation of the Pastor.

Those being Baptized, or at least one of the parents/guardians of an infant or child to be baptized, will ordinarily be active members of the New Castle Presbyterian

Church or another Christian congregation. Exceptions are at the discretion of the Pastor and the Session.

Baptism takes place within a worship service.

Baptism as an Act of the Church

Baptism is a Holy Sacrament and a serious commitment involving public vows before God and the Christian family of faith. It involves responsive participation by the congregation of faith.

Therefore, Baptism is celebrated during a regularly scheduled service of Worship. The congregation promises to guide and nurture those being baptized in their faith and so acts as a community of godparents. Though there are no designated individual godparents, relatives and sponsors are welcome to join those being baptized with the Pastor at the Sacrament of Baptism.

Policies regarding recording during a worship service will be observed. For example, unobtrusive video recording from the balcony and natural light photography may be permitted. Flash photography is not permitted.

Baptism is the sign of God's grace and our response to that grace. We reaffirm the covenant of our baptism throughout our lives that we may be empowered to be faithful disciples in our world.

Do you promise, through prayer and example, to support and encourage (name) to be a faithful Christian?
